RULES AND REGULATIONS

All exhibitors are required to thoroughly acquaint themselves with all federal and state laws governing horses and horse shows.

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and regulations of the current USEF rulebook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Show Management will resolve any questions not covered by the USEF rulebook and such decisions of show management will be final. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to submit entries that do not constitute a violation of these provisions.

The Gasparilla Charity Horse Show reserves the right to decline any exhibitor and/or exhibitor's horses before the show and reserves the right to order any exhibitor and/or exhibitor's horses from the premises without being held liable for damages of any kind and this shall be accepted as a condition of entry. In this event, all entry fees paid and prize money won shall be forfeited.

USEF ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation – licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and the Rules of the Federation and the competition. I will accept as final the decisions of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport of the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. (GR 908.4)

Entries: Entries close on **February 16, 2009**. Entries must be on the official entry form for this show. Only one horse per entry form. The complete name and address of the registered owner must appear on the entry form. Mail the completed form to the address on the entry form, along with a check for all fees, a photocopy of the registration papers and Coggins Test for all horses entered and copies all required membership cards.

Entries will be accepted until February 16, 2009 at the regular rate. Post entries will be accepted thereafter at double the regular rate until one hour prior to the session.

Post entry charge will not apply in Championship Classes

All fees shall be paid in full at the time of entry closing. The show will not accept post dated or open checks for entries and stall fees.

Stalls: Permanent box stalls with doors will be provided. Fee: \$110.00 per stall. **Stall doors must not be removed.** The Florida State Fairgrounds will assess a damage fee to any exhibitor removing a stall door.

Stalls will be available beginning on Saturday February 28. Arrival prior to Saturday February 28 will be considered early arrival and a fee of \$16.50 per stall will be charged. Stalls MUST be vacated by noon on Sunday March 8, 2009. If you must stay beyond that time, you must make arrangements directly with the Florida State Fair Authority and pay a fee of \$16.50 per stall per day.

Office Charge: There will be a \$25.00 charge per horse for all horse entered in the show – this fee will not be refunded under any circumstances.

Refund Policy: Refund requests received prior to the closing of entries will be made in full; except for the \$25.00 office charge. Refund requests made after the closing of entries on February 16, 2009 must be delivered in person or sent by registered or certified mail to be received prior to March 2, 2009. These requests must be on a veterinarian's letterhead addressed to the Show Secretary. If the above is complied with, a refund of entry fees will be made less the \$25.00 office fee. Stall fees will not be refunded. Refund requests made after March 2, 2009 will not be honored.

Feed & Bedding: All feed and bedding orders must be placed and pre paid with the Florida State Fairgrounds Horse Show Office 813 740 3500. **IT WILL NO LONGER BE POSSIBLE TO CHARGE FEED & BEDDING TO YOUR SHOW ACCOUNT.**

Measurement Cards: Ponies must have a valid measurement card or form. Ponies will be measured at a designated time on Tuesday March 3, 2009. Please check in the show office for time and location.

Prize Money: All premiums will be paid by check and mailed within 30 days after the show.

Box Seats: Box seats are available on either side of the show ring for all sessions. Table and six (6) seats -- \$ need price. These may be ordered on the entry form. Please designate the name to be displayed for each box.

Health Certificates and Coggins Test: State law mandates that each exhibitor be in possession of a negative Coggins Test conducted within the past twelve (12) months on each horse entered. A copy of the coggins test must be submitted with the entries. All out of state horses must possess a health certificate issued by a veterinarian within 30 days of the Gasparilla Charity Horse Show with temperature recording on each animal. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be familiar with the rules regarding animals in the State of Florida.

Camper Parking: Water and electrical hookups will be available to exhibitors. Please make reservations by calling the Florida State Fair Authority – Security Division 813 621 7821 Ext 268.

Florida Owned/Trained Horses: These designated classes are restricted to owners who are residents of Florida and horses must be stabled in Florida 60 days prior to the closing date of entries.

Responsibility: Neither the Gasparilla Charity Horse Show, its management, sponsors, employees or independent contractors will be responsible for any article of any kind or nature that is lost, destroyed or stolen, nor liable for any injury sustained to horses, exhibitors, spectators or employees. Barn calls are a courtesy.

Dogs: Dogs are discouraged. If they are present, they must be on a leash at all times. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Show Ring In Gate Closing: All entries are advised to come to the warm up ring prior to their class and check in with the Paddock Master. The gate to the show ring will be closed two minutes after the first entry enters the show ring. The show ring will close one hour prior to each session.

Horse Show Facilities: The Gasparilla Charity Horse Show is held in the Lykes Arena at the Florida State Fairgrounds in Tampa FL. The ring dimensions are 125' x 247' and the footing in both the show ring and warm up area is dirt, sand and sawdust.

NO WHIPS LONGER THAN SIX FEET WILL BE ALLOWED AT THE RING SIDE OR WARM UP AREAS. Fire extinguishers and explosives used as training aids are prohibited on the show grounds before, during or after the show.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program; 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes. MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of a licensed competition. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

MAP & DIRECTIONS

The Florida State Fairgrounds is located off Interstate 4, east of Tampa. From the West take Exit 6 (Orient Road) off I4 and turn right and then left into the entrance for the fairgrounds. From the East take US 92 off I4, turn left on Orient Road. The fairgrounds will be just past the I4 overpass to the left.

UPHA Chapter 16 Academy Rules & Regulations

These rules have been established by the trainers, instructors and show committees of the UPHA Chapter 16

The Academy Division is open only to riders who have never competed in a regular horse show in full show attire for their respective division. Riders must be competing on an Academy horse.

Academy Horse is defined as a horse of any breed that is regularly used in a professionally operated lesson program. An academy horse may be privately owned, however, in addition to being used in the lesson program, someone other than the horses' owner must also show it in competition. The Academy horse must display safe manners and characteristics desired of a lesson horse. A plain shod horse is required; one pad and/or therapeutic wedge is allowed. Desired is a clean, well turned out horse, hoof blacking is optional, and braiding is only allowed in the hunt seat classes. Horses are not to be judged; way of going is not to be considered.

Tack: Horses are to be tacked according to the division the rider is competing in. Instructors are encouraged to bridle their horses in a safe manner; tie downs, standing martingales or blinkers are not allowed.

Attire: For the Saddle Seat Rider: jodphurs, jodhpur boots or paddock boots, long sleeve, button down or collared shirt, tie and gloves are required. Vests are optional, no derbies allowed. For the Hunt Seat Rider: breeches, and an appropriate hunt seat shirt, hunt boots or paddock boots and gloves are required. "Polo" shirts are not allowed. For the Western Rider: appropriate western shirt, pants, tie, boots and gloves are required. Chaps or western hats are not allowed. In all divisions safety helmets are optional and strongly encouraged.

Class Rules: Headers are allowed in if needed for safety, no whips or towels allowed in the show ring. Classes will be split at the 13th rider; splits will be shuffled to keep Equitation and showmanship back to back for each age group. Class holds will be 2 minutes in length. NO EXCEPTIONS. Equitation Classes are judged on the riders basic equitation skills with correct diagonals and leads to be counted; proper use of the show ring is to be considered. Showmanship classes are judged on the rider's horsemanship abilities. They are judged on a rider's ability to control and show their horse, including speed, collectiveness and placement in the ring. In canter classes, promptness in finding the correct lead is important as well as the rider's command of the horse.
